

## In My Life This Week

*(As you use this daily guide, write out your observations and responses on a separate piece of paper and save them with this sheet for reference.)*

**Monday.** Read 1:1-14. Verse 3 is the beginning of a grand statement of praise to God. Start memorizing this verse today and reflect on the blessings that are listed in verses 3-14.

**Tuesday.** Keep working on memorizing or refreshing your memorization of verse 3. If you are a believer, God has showered you with His grace. Review the meaning of “grace,” and note the descriptions in verses 6-8 (you can check your notes from Sunday and a Bible dictionary or the back of your Bible to see if it has a dictionary of terms). Thank God for His great grace to you.

**Wednesday.** In grace God redeemed you (verses 7-8). Write out your own description of redemption, or of being redeemed. As we approach Good Friday, remember the cost of your redemption (e.g., 1 Peter 1:18-19). How are you going to worship and praise God for this on Friday?

**Thursday.** In grace God revealed the mystery of His will to sum up everything in Jesus Christ (verses 8-10). What does this statement mean? What is its importance to you? Have you memorized verse 3 yet?

**Friday – Saturday.** Today (Friday), of course is Good Friday. In and beyond the service today, focus on Christ’s great love and sacrifice for you. Sunday is Easter and we will celebrate Christ’s resurrection.
