Jesus Is The Redeemer.

1. The basic idea of redemption. (Psalm 51:5; John 8:34; Romans 3:20, 23; 5:12 f.)
2. God, the Redeemer, provides redemption. (Psalm 19:14; Isaiah 44:6; Mark 10:45; Luke 1:68-69; 2:29-32; Ephesians 1:7; 1 Peter 1:18-19; 1 John 5:19)

Jesus Redeems Us From ...

1. Sin. (Romans 3:24 with 6:7, 14; Titus 2:14; Hebrews 2:15)
2. Being under the Law and its curse. (Galatians 3:13; 4:5; cf. Deuteronomy 21:23; 28:15-68)
3. From Satan's realm of darkness. (Galatians 1:4; Colossians 1:13; 1 John 5:19)
4. Futility. (Galatians 4:8; 1 Peter 1:18; cf. Ecclesiastes 1:2, 13-14, 17; 2:11, 17 etc.)

Jesus Redeems Us To ...

1. Forgiveness of our sins. (Matthew 26:28; Luke 1:77-78; Acts 2:38; 10:43; Romans 10:13; Ephesians 1:7; Colossians 1:14; 1 John 1:9)
2. Being justified and righteous. (Romans 3:24, 28; 4:5; 5:9, 17, 18, 19; 6:18; 10:10; 1 Corinthians 6:11; 2 Corinthians 5:21; Galatians 2:16; Ephesians 4:24; Philippians 3:9)
3. Everlasting life. (John 3:15-16, 36; 6:40; 10:27-29; 17:3; Romans 5:21; 6:22-23; Colossians 1:13; 1 Timothy 1:16; 1 John 5:11-12)

4. Being under grace. (John 1:14, 16-17; Acts 20:24, 32; Romans 5:2, 21; 6:14-15; 2 Corinthians 9:14; 2 Timothy 2:1; 2 Peter 3:18)
5. Purity. (Ephesians 1:4; 5:25-27; Titus 2:14; 1 Peter 1:15-16; 2:5; 1 John 3:3; Revelation 20:6)
6. The Holy Spirit being within us. (John 14:16-17, 26; 16:14-15; Romans 8:9; Galatians 3:14; Ephesians 1:13-14; 4:30)
7. Serving God. (Romans 6:13, 18; 12:6-8; 1 Corinthians 4:1; 2 Corinthians 3:6; Ephesians 4:7-16; Titus 2:14; 1 Peter 4:10)

In My Life This Week

(As you use this daily guide, write out your observations and responses on a separate piece of paper and save them with this sheet for reference.)

Monday. This week we are focusing on Jesus as our *Remarkable Redeemer*. The basic concept of redemption is to buy or ransom someone or something. Many, if not most, people today do not think they need to be redeemed. “Redeemed from what? Why?” Start with the Scripture passages on the outline and review our need and God’s provision of the Redeemer, Jesus Christ. Thank God for His redemption. Be ready to talk with others about their need for Jesus as their Redeemer.

Tuesday. We surveyed four of the things that Jesus redeems us *from* on Sunday. Go over those today. Keep them in your mind throughout the day as an ongoing prompter of praise. Without Jesus we would still be enslaved by sin, under the Law and its curse, bound in Satan’s realm of darkness and spinning our wheels in futility.

Wednesday. We looked briefly at seven of the things that Jesus redeemed us *to*. Walk through them, noting both the accomplished fact and your own progress in understanding, living in light of and living out these remarkable truths. How do they affect your celebration of Christmas?

Thursday. There is no better time than this season to share the good news of Jesus the *Remarkable Redeemer* with people who do not yet know Him. How are you doing in living and speaking for Him as we come close to the half way point of the season?

Friday/Saturday. On Sunday we plan to move to our third theme for this Advent season—*Wonder Of Wonders*. Think about why and how wonderful Jesus is as you prepare for our time together.
