

In My Life This Week

Monday. Job says “I have heard of You by the hearing of the ear; but now my eye sees you.” When was the last time you honestly could concur with Job in saying “now my eye sees you”? Check the barometer of your faith. Are you walking with God everyday or are you just waiting for something to happen?

Tuesday. Read again the description of Behemoth and Leviathan. Is there something in nature that evokes a similar awe in you? Something that makes you say, “Wow God. I don’t know how or why you make this, but you did.” Take a moment to praise God in prayer.

Wednesday. Humility is one of the objectives of the book of Job. Have you been humble recently in your interactions with God? What about with those around you? Family? Co-workers? Friends? Confess any false pride that may have crept into your life.

Thursday. Job reminds us that none of God’s purposes can be thwarted. Read Romans 8:28-30. Think back and praise God for how He has time and time again made it possible for you to take on the likeness of His Son.

Friday – Saturday. Pastor Lyle will be finishing our series on Job on Sunday. Read chapter 42 and prepare your heart for worship. Pray that God will speak to you through His Word.
